## Put God First

Begin with Gratitude - Honor God today.

for direction and success. (Proverbs 6:3)

Decide now the one big thing you will complete today. Daniel created a distinguishing reputation of excellence by the way he worked day by day. His excellence got the attention of the king who set him in charge over the whole kingdom. (Daniel 6:3.)

# 3

## Practice in Prison

Help someone today - even if your own plan is still a work in progress.

(The struggle is real which is why you want to capture this secret.). Look beyond yourself and open a door, lend a hand, speak an encouraging word to one who needs a hand up. Joseph interpreted dreams for others while in a prison cell. His gift made a way for him later to step into the 2nd highest position in the land. Watch for the opportunity today to use your gifts in this season of your own development. (Read Genesis 14:14-15)

## Lead with Confidence

Deborah led in unlikely times for a woman. She inspired and escorted a military leader to fight a necessary battle. She led a group of people to freedom all because she said “Yes” to stepping out even though she’d never led like this before. Her leadership inspired others to new levels. The ancient secret says she moved others to “great resolve of heart.” (Read Judges 5) For now, lead with confidence and passion today in the assignments God opens for you and inspire others to action.

## Forgive Quickly

Keep a short account of offenses and take a success tip from Joseph.

Remember that even when you are wronged, God can turn it all around and use it for good. Offense blocks your communication lines with God and others, shuts you down. You want to choose the opposite approach that leads to life, progress, and God-made success. When you forgive, watch for the good things that overtake you and bring solutions to those around you. It's a win-win. (Genesis 50:20.)
